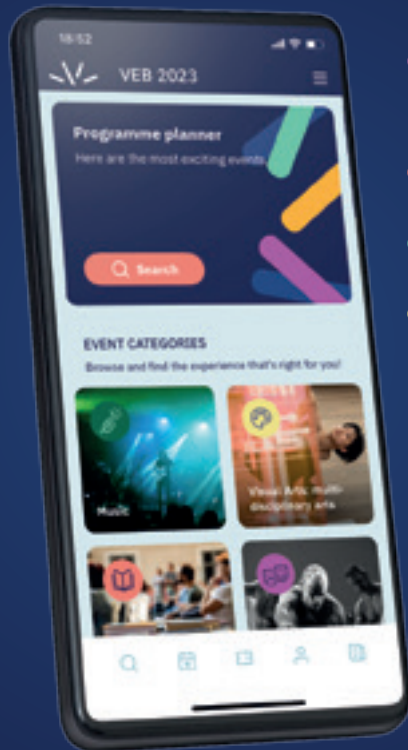

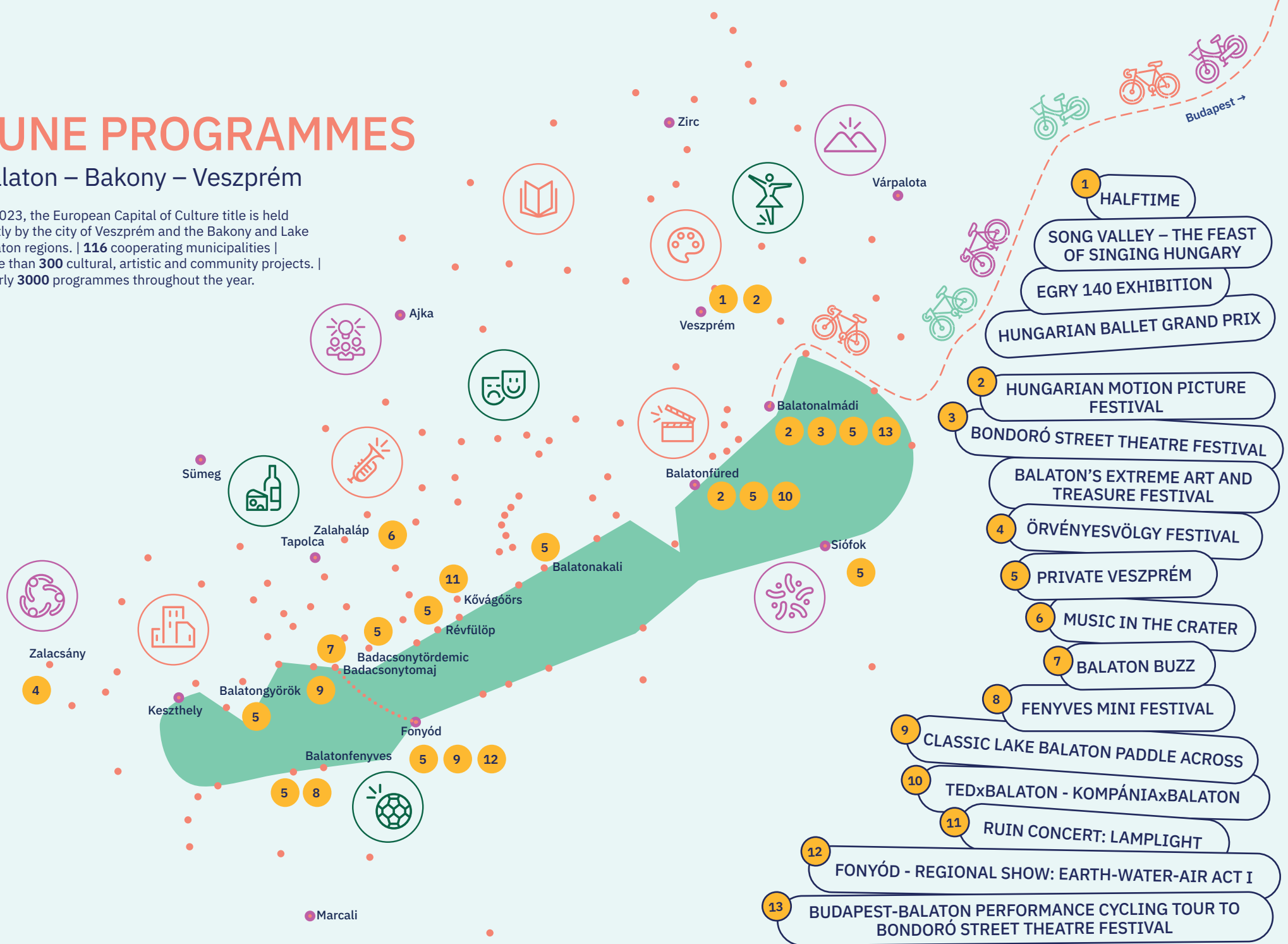

FOUR DAYS OF SINGING IN DALVÖLGY (SONG VALLEY)



Choirs from the Carpathian Basin meet in Veszprém

In the first days of June, the streets and squares of Veszprém and its surroundings are filled with singing. Dalvölgy and its related programmes are a meeting place for Hungarian choirs and their audiences both from the territory of Hungary and Hungarian minority regions from surrounding countries.

A professional event for conductors, a meeting of people who love to sing, an experience for the audience - that's what Dalvölgy is all about. The programme organised by the Veszprém City Mixed Choir Association includes several events.

The by now well-established Meeting of Hungarian Choirs will be held on 1st and 2nd June, providing an opportunity for Hungarian choirs from the Carpathian Basin and the diaspora of the West to present themselves and build professional and friendly relations.

The meeting could also help to revitalise the musical scene, as the pandemic conditions of recent years have had an adverse impact on choirs: their numbers, activities and community events have been weakened, and in many cases their long-term viability is in jeopardy. Opportunities to meet, train and perform have been lost. The June event will also include a choral conducting course with presentations and discussions in which experts will seek creative solutions to cultural, community and psychological challenges.

Saturday marks the highlight of the event with Dalvölgy taking place in the ActiCity open-air space on 3rd June, all afternoon long. "With more than sixty choirs coming to the event, there will be over 1,300 singers in total. Dalvölgy is not a showcase of individual groups, but a programme of combined choirs. The repertoire is based on Hungarian music literature, but the programmes will include a variety of choral works from different genres, such as folk song arrangements, church music, early music, oratorio and vocal popular music. There will be 15-minute blocks followed by a sing-along with all participants and the audience," said artistic director choirmaster Ágnes Erdélyi.

The final day of the event, 4th June, is the Day of National Unity. On this day, the guest choirs will perform at concerts, church services and community events in several villages of the Bakony-Balaton region. Dalvölgy lives on not only in terms of experiences, but also in terms of professional content: the collaboration of choral professionals brings new strength, while the programme of performances by the choirs and the music booklet of the collective songs renew the repertoire of Hungarian choral music.

CINEMA NIGHTS BY LAKE BALATON CELEBRATING HUNGARIAN FILM

The Hungarian Motion Picture Festival is a celebration of Hungarian film in the Veszprém-Balaton region, a special experience for audiences and a bustling meeting place for Hungarian filmmakers. With the latest Hungarian films, fascinating stars, unforgettable cinema experiences and artist-meets-audience event, movie fans are welcome to cinemas in Veszprém, Balatonfüred and Balatonalmádi and to open-air screenings on pleasantly cool Balaton evenings.

Organised in cooperation with the National Film Institute and under the auspices of the Hungarian Film Academy, film fans are welcome to watch nearly one hundred Hungarian films at nine locations in Veszprém, Balatonfüred and Balatonalmádi for the symbolic price of HUF 500.

The event is the biggest festival of Hungarian film, so audiences will be treated to the best films of the past year. On 7th June, the event will start with a gala screening of *Gold of the Nation* in Veszprém's Trinity Square. The heroes of this gripping documentary are the Hungarian water polo legends who beat the rest of the world between 1997 and 2008. Every year, the Hungarian Motion Picture Festival revisits some of the iconic classics of Hungarian cinema.

This year, György Fehér's 1989 film *Twilight*, based on Friedrich Dürrenmatt's novel *The Promise*, will be screened, in which the inspector played by Péter Haumann

investigates a series of child murders and uses a little girl to trap the perpetrator. The world premiere of the restored version of the film was held in February at the 73rd Berlin International Film Festival - the first screening of the film in Hungary will take place at our festival.

In line with international trends and in keeping with tradition, this year's Hungarian Motion Picture Awards, chaired by world-renowned cinematographer and director Lajos Koltai, will be presented to the films in competition and their creators by editor and director Katalin Bakos, actor-director Kata Dobó, film producer Ákos Pesti and director-cameraman János Vecsernyés. They will do so after the jury selects the shortlisted films and the nominees for the Hungarian Motion Picture Awards out of nearly 200 entries.

The host of the Hungarian Film Festival this year is journalist Gerda Seres.

Anyone arriving by train from anywhere in the country can buy a ticket to Veszprém at a discounted price of HUF 2023.

Everyone is welcome at Foton

In the European Capital of Culture year, new programme and community spaces are opening up. One of the highlights is Foton Audiovisual Centre to open to the public on 6th June.

A screening room, a café, an exhibition space, a renewed hanging gardens - spaces for various community and cultural events will be created at 17 Vár utca (St).

The long-vacant building and its courtyard, as well as the Fire Watchtower Courtyard and the Castle Wall Walkway, will be redeveloped as a coherent space, a multifunctional arts and cultural centre.

And why is it called Foton?

"We were looking for a name that was easy to understand internationally, simple yet symbolic of the fact that we will be hosting a diverse programme with a focus on visual arts," said Programme Director Viktória Szántó.

Foton will also host an art cinema, meeting a long-standing demand of the people of Veszprém.

In addition to new contemporary art films and thematic film clubs, the cinema will

also screen American blockbusters like the new Indiana Jones film - most of them in the original language, so it's worth going to the cinema to learn languages.

There will be literary evenings, concerts, workshops and conferences. We'll have a wide range of artistic disciplines: literature, theatre, film, music and visual arts.



We offer programmes for all age groups: there will be opportunities specifically aimed at young people, families and even senior citizens. We dreamed up a cosy venue, an art centre on a Veszprém scale. We would like Foton to be a meeting point where we can address the cultural scene nationwide." - the programme director says.

The basement and gallery of the building will house Fixir media lab, the digital creation workshop of the House of Arts.

The café will be an essential part of Foton, where guests can enjoy specialty coffees and at night it will function as a bar.

In good weather, the garden area will also be transformed into a café.

All this will allow the cultural centre to operate in an operationally sustainable way in the long term. An open-air stage and auditorium have been built in the courtyard of the Fire Watchtower, so you can enjoy theatre performances, musical evenings or family afternoons in the open air, and don't forget special open-air cinema screenings!

After the opening ceremony on 6th June, the Hungarian Motion Picture Festival starts, and Foton will be one of the main venues, so the new community spaces will immediately get packed.

FIXIR Gallery and Media Lab Opened

Digital natives no longer understand how we spend long minutes in front of a picture on a wall. Of course, art can still be interesting and valuable to them, even if in a different way to previous generations. The nanosecond attention and the spectacle falling on quarks also require novel forms of presentation from art institutions.

VR, 4K, 3D, AI - are you familiar with these terms? Those who are will certainly feel at home at Fixir; those who aren't will certainly get the hang of it.

House of Arts Veszprém has created Fixir Gallery and Media Lab in the former Várkert restaurant building.

"In the gallery, we can offer special experiences such as standing in the middle of a projection with frames scrolling around you on each wall of the room. From June, the gallery will host six exhibitions: projected images, light and digital art. But the space is also suitable for exhibitions with traditional installations," said Gábor Áfrány head of Fixir and curator of House of Arts Veszprém.

Just how special this spectacle is will be revealed to the very first guests of the opening. At 19.00, 17th June, NYX, an interactive audiovisual installation by Glowing Bulbs and Marcell Andristyak will be on show. This four-walled - immersive - projection will take visitors on a search for light in an eerie, strange, nocturnal interactive journey among strange objects and creatures.

"The two project rooms in the basement of the Media Arts Centre will serve as a venue for workshops and workshops with innovative themes, new technologies and techniques, which will also be linked to the contemporary art programmes of House of Arts Veszprém.

The first workshop will be led by Judit Navratil, who will introduce participants to the mysteries of 3D drawing with VR goggles. In June, participants will be able to create art with the help of AI, i.e. artificial intelligence."

From September, the workshops will be replaced by sessions for secondary school students and young adults.

The name of Fixir fittingly appears as follows: f|x|r

The word has many meanings: for analogue photography enthusiasts, it is no news that it is the fixing medium of film. The fact that two vertical lines break the word - replacing the vowels - brings it close to the computer world. F(x) refers to the function, and FX to effects.

This year, Bondoró Festival moves to Balatonalmádi

This year, the fifth Bondoró will feature great innovations and a more colourful programme than ever before. A host of international street theatre attractions, major concerts and, last but not least, a unique new venue await those who visit the event this year.

The 5th Bondoró International Street Theatre Festival is looking forward to welcoming old and new guests in Balatonalmádi, right on the shores of Lake Balaton, in Öreg (Old) Park. The shady groves of shady trees will not only be home to Bondoró's familiar venues, which have been with us since the beginning, but also to a range of new stages.

In addition to Hungarian performers, audiences will be able to see 24 international productions from 10 nations between 30th June and 2nd July. On the main stage, the band Lóci Játsszik will perform and Fran Palermo will also give a concert. On Saturday, the Firebirds will present their new circus show Restlesslegs, and on Sunday, Eva Duda Company will put on a dynamic show entitled I Shall be Free.

There will also be performances by László Gulyás travelling musician, marionette artist Bence Sarkadi, Kajárpéci Vízirevű and KL Theatre. Also returning this year are mime artist Béla Stubnya and Mimuido, brought to life by Fedor Guido Szarka.

There will be spectacular illuminated giant puppets from the French Compagnie Remue Ménage, but you can also meet members of the Circus of the Inkhorn, Danny Bain's music machine and even have your fortune told. Kabóca Puppet Theatre's own giant puppets,

along with many others, will appear during the main stage concerts. Actress Lia Pokorny will perform a musical evening, while László Kollár-Klemencz and András Lovasi will give a solo performance at Bondoró. The audience will see a concert by Boróka Beck aka Boebeck, and performances by András Áron 'Apey', the Meg Egy Cukorka band, Krisztián Grecsó and Balázs Szabó. Every year, the festive closing performance of the festival is a fire show of the phoenix, the totem animal of Bondoró.

This year, our favourite bird will be set alight in a special international fire theatre co-production, thanks to the local Firebirds and the Czech Mask Bureau company.



After the parade, the closing concert will be given by the band Elephant.

In addition to the concerts, accompanying programmes await visitors to Halftime, like the International Storytelling Conference, which will be held for the first time this year between 14th and 16th June, followed by Pannon StoryFest international storytelling festival on 16th and 17th June. While the conference will primarily be aimed at professionals, it will be open to the general public, with storytelling tours and entertaining performances about the history and legends of Veszprém, for people of all ages. In addition to fairy tales, the special world of operetta will be brought to life at Rátonyi Róbert Operetta Festival organised by Petőfi Theatre between 15th and 18th June.

During this time, you can also enjoy unique, surround-sound symphonic concerts in the centre of Veszprém, which, as an added bonus, will also offer a unique visual experience. Sports fans can enjoy extreme sports from morning to evening on Saturday, 17th and 18th June, and there will also be a roller skate discotheque on both days, where you can dance to your favourite old and new hits. Art enthusiasts can also explore the temporary and permanent exhibitions of House of Arts Veszprém on Halftime days, and Papírkutya Culture Bistro is also preparing with concerts.

TALES FOR ADULTS



Storytellers from All Over Europe Come to Veszprém

There are still storytellers out there today - if you don't believe me, find out for yourself! The International Storytelling Festival is a unique opportunity to meet them.

In mid-June, more than a hundred and fifty storytellers come to Veszprém to bring with them one of the most special events of the summer.

„How folk storytelling has evolved into what it is today is a very important and interesting question. It used to be a form of entertainment to chase away boredom in community spinning

houses, but by now this has changed.

For example, fairy tales have become a part of therapeutic, pedagogical and language teaching methods - this will also be discussed - but also in the hospitality industry,” said Zsolt Pintér, president of Csúrdöngölő Cultural Association and storyteller.

First, the storytellers from all over the world will attend the itinerant conference of the Federation for European Storytelling, a European professional organisation, and then, on 16th and 17th June, they will surprise the public with their tales of nations: the doors of

Dubniczay Palace will open wide for the launch of the International Storytelling Festival. The event is not only a fun programme, but can also be useful for language learning. And as fairy tales were once a genre for adults, there will be plenty of performances for adult ears, alongside a wealth of children's activities.

„The audience will also hear performances that will be new even to us.

For example, our Italian colleagues will perform erotic stories from Boccaccio's Decameron in English, which will be translated into Hungarian. There will also be several other performances in English.

We are fond of Hungarian folktales, so you can hear them told in live performances all day long. There will be a fairy-tale trail where anyone can follow the path of the storyteller and experience their lives.”

People of all ages are welcome to Old Town Square, where there will also be dance and



puppet theatre performances closely linked to the fairy tale genre, and storytellers will be on hand all day Friday and Saturday in the yurt in the theatre gardens.

Admission is free, but pre-registration is required for some performances and can be done at www.csurdongolo.hu.

The Czardas Queen, The Kissing Lady, Lehár songs and popular melodies: the Rátonyi Róbert Operetta Festival in Veszprém, organised by the Petőfi Theatre in Veszprém, awaits operetta lovers between 15th and 18th June. Interactive children's performances, amusement park attractions and professional discussions will also be part of the event.

Róbert Rátonyi, one of operetta's brightest stars, spent the last four years of his artistic career in Veszprém. His memory is honoured with Rátonyi Róbert Operetta Festival, one of the city's flagship festivals.

The aim of Petőfi Theatre of Veszprém is to offer a family-friendly programme and bring the genre closer to as many people as possible.

At 18.00, 15th June, the event starts with a live music show in Holy Trinity Square, followed by a horseback and carriage procession to some of the city's special balconies and then to the square in front of the theatre.

The Festival Opening Gala will start here at 20.00, with a dazzling show featuring a host of operetta stars, artists, dancers and musicians.

Petőfi Theatre of Veszprém will host one of Imre Kálmán's best-known and most popular operettas, *The Czardas Queen* on 16th June, *The Kissing Lady* on 17th June and the *International Operetta Gala* on 18th June. All performances start at 19.00.

A series of shows by renowned performers, talks with famous actors and events for children will complement the four-day festival, which will open each day with *GastrOperetta*, a culinary delights stand offering themed food.

In an unconventional way, various places in Veszprém will also feature operetta hits - restaurant and café terraces, balconies, residential areas and parks.

At 22.00 on 18th June, the closing day, a Live Music Operetta Closing Carnival will take place on the square in front of the theatre: with great atmosphere, dancing and singing together, fun until dawn and lots of surprises!

Örvényesvölgy Festival in Zalacsány offers a stunning setting in the hills of Zala County, with stages set against a forest backdrop. With support from the Veszprém-Balaton 2023 European Capital of Culture Programme, several international stars will make an appearance, and the programme also includes jazz specialities, literary programmes and e-bike tours.



Bringing 7 guitars, a 12-piece orchestra and hot flamenco, salsa and pop tunes, the band will take certainly take over our main stage. One of the world's most popular bands, the artists behind the hits Bamboleo, Baila Me, Volare, Djobi, djoba and many other globally known songs have released 13 music albums and received numerous Grammy nominations." Audiences will also be treated to other musical delicacies.

The programmes of the first weekend are based on Hungarian traditions and Hungarian folk music, with a variety of children's programmes, special concerts and evening barn dancing. On top of all that, there is a unique event for guests to enjoy at a Hungarian festival. An archaeological dig will take place on site allowing the public to join in.

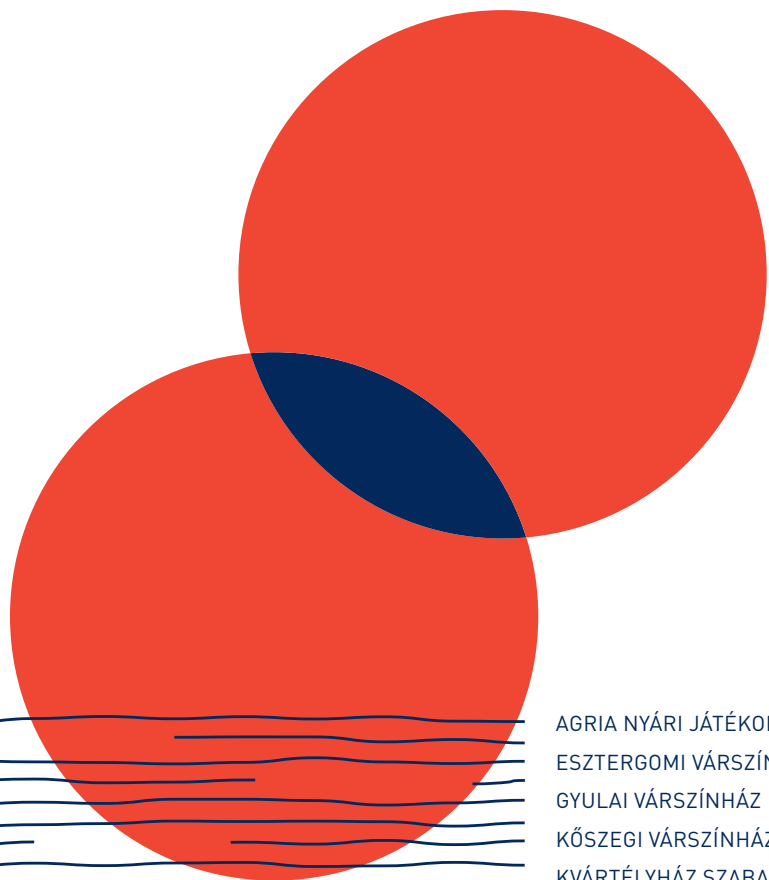

Joining the European Capital of Culture programme, MÁV-Volán Group has introduced a symbolic-price Veszprém-Balaton 2023 ECoC

ticket, which is also valid in the GYSEV area. The reduced-price ticket can be purchased at the time of the featured events and can be used on the day of the event or the previous day on the way there, and on the day of the event or the following day for the return journey. It's not just discount fares that transport companies offer.



- Volánbusz and MÁV also run night services during key events.
- To coincide with the evening events of the programme of events, a night relief express train will run to the capital on Saturdays and public holidays until 28th October.
- The new service will depart from Veszprém at 23.41 after the end of the late evening programme and will offer a return journey to the capital, Székesfehérvár and the surrounding villages accessible by rail: Hajmáskér, Pétfürdő, Öskü and Várpalota. The train is also connected to the late evening local service of the local V-Bus company.
- The pre-season timetable of MÁV-START is valid until 16th June, providing a better and more frequent connection to Lake Balaton.
- During the high season from 17th June to 27th August, as well as in the post-season period, passengers will be offered comfortable and frequent rail and bus services.

“A true artist does not join styles;

140 paintings from the oeuvre of the artist born 140 years ago. The exhibition at Laczkó Dezső Museum, opening on 24th June, will showcase works from József Egrý's mature period until 29th October.

He concentrated on Lake Balaton with every fibre of his being and every twitch of his nerves, he lived in a special symbiosis with the lake and the landscape, and was already considered a painter of Lake Balaton during his lifetime. This is József Egrý, who came into the world 140 years ago. On the anniversary of his birth, Laczkó Dezső Museum presents an exhibition of his mature works created between the two world wars. “This is not a classic exhibition of his life's work. We focus on Egrý's mature art. This is the period from after World War I, from the time he settled at Lake Balaton, until his death: from 1919 to 1951.

The focus of the exhibition will be on Balaton paintings, juxtaposed with the works Egrý made during his two trips to Italy,” said curator and art historian Anna Sipos. Most of Egrý's Italian paintings were acquired directly by private collectors in the 1930s, while some of the works on display are on loan from art collectors. The majority of the exhibition consists of works

held in the collections of several museums in Budapest and across the country, mainly in kept in storage. “Egrý is known as the painter of Lake Balaton, but it was not water that was the focus of his painting - it was light. He was trying to capture the way light refracts on a couple sitting over the water. That is why he favoured the depiction of approaching or passing storm and the rainbow.

In addition to these phenomena, he was also fascinated by depictions of ordinary people. He captured animals drinking in Lake Balaton, and the figures of boaters and sailors often appear in his works, as do Badacsony Hill and the grape harvest'. The paintings are accompanied by sounds. On the web and Facebook pages, YouTube and SoundCloud channels of the Laczkó Dezső Museum, you can listen to interviews with the painter from the past, as well as to the audio material of Krisztián Nyáry's essay about József Egrý and Juliska Pauler.



JOURNEYS AND THE ARTIST'S QUEST

This is How Young Egrý
Worked

Far from commonplaces. This is the telling title of the exhibition opening at Dubniczay Palace at 19.00 on 24th June. The exhibition presents the works of József Egrý from his youth.

Paris, Bruges, Budapest, Badacsony - these four were the cities that defined the life of József Egrý. It was here that he became acquainted with the art of the period, and where he distanced himself from the learning processes typical of art academies.

House of Arts Veszprém presents the period of the painter between 1901 and 1918, on the occasion of the 140th anniversary of his birth. “We thought it is worth showing how the artist's career started. It also gives a European horizon to his oeuvre, since he arrived in Paris in 1905. He got to know the art of the period and absorbed the atmosphere of turn-of-the-century Paris, all that the city had to offer and meant to the art scene of the time,” Bernadett Grászli, director of the House of Arts in Veszprém, recalls.

Due to financial difficulties, Egrý returned to Hungary in 1906 and, thanks to patronage, he was able to begin his studies at the Academy of Fine Arts.

The exhibition will introduce visitors to this period, including the experiences of a trip to Belgium.

“Our aim is to try to capture József Egrý's early career, which is also linked to Art Nouveau, Symbolism, figurative painting and the world of Expressionism. This period was a real quest in Egrý's life: he was trying to find his artistic voice. His memoirs also show that he very soon said that he wanted to create art without constraints and empty phrases. He soon left the Academy of Fine Arts because of these constraints and, having found his own artistic voice, developed into one of the most outstanding personalities in Hungarian fine art. The exhibition was organised in collaboration with Laczkó Dezső Museum, which holds a prestigious collection of the artist's early work. In addition, a number of paintings on loan from renowned private and public collections will be on display until 27th August.

COMMUNITY BUILDING AROUND LAKE BALATON

Interactive Theatre in Balatonudvari, Highlands and Transylvanian Barn Dancing in Balatonvilágos

The Provisional College of the National Cultural Fund Veszprém-Balaton 2023 European Capital of Culture supports heritage and cultural community-building programmes in the Lake Balaton area. The impact of the programmes will extend beyond the funding period, adding to the quality and wealth of the European Capital of Culture's cultural programmes.

Together for Balatonudvari Association, for example, has used the funding to implement artistic and cultural programmes in the village that are gap-filling, lesser known and not easily accessible to the public in the area. The primary aim was to encourage active participation and networking among the audience, and to ensure that the community-building impact of the programmes would be felt beyond the grant period. It was also a priority to bring together residents, those who had moved in during the pandemic and those with holiday homes.

The interactive theatre was a new feature of the programme, a detective game combined with dinner, but the success of the children's programme was also beyond all expectations. Not for the last 15 years have so many children been involved in the same programme, which is unique because the municipality has neither a nursery nor a school and even children of the same age go to different institutions.

Courtesy of the National Cultural Fund, the Spring Twin Settlement Cultural Meeting was held in Balatonvilágos, which sought to fill the gaps in social relations caused by the pandemic. To this end, a delegation from Telekfalva in Transylvania and Gímes in the Highlands came to Balatonvilágos to present a sample of their culture to the other two settlements and the public of Balatonvilágos. The well-attended evening ended with barn dancing to Transylvanian and Highland songs, and next year's meeting was already being planned.

FROM FLEA MARKET TO EXHIBITION HALL



What is for one person an object to be sold, an object considered a joke, may be a work of art for others. Erik Kessels and Thomas Mailaender have collected relics from European flea markets. The exhibition at Dubniczay Palace in Veszprém is collective memory woven out of these objects.

Our main goal as European Capital of Culture Veszprém-Balaton 2023 is to present the cultural-creative region with the toolkit of contemporary art and fresh approaches. As part of our Balaton Eye art and photography residency programmes, internationally renowned artists come to us and during their stay they process, filter and present the past and present of the Lake Balaton region through their own art.

This programme will also include the Europe Archive contemporary exhibition, featuring the joint work of Erik Kessels and Thomas Mailaender. The Dutch and French artists will present objects found at flea markets across Europe, including the 'Polish market' in Veszprém, fragments of European culture with a personal voice of their own.

Art historian and curator of the exhibition Claudia Küssel recalled the creative process, which involved a lot of travelling around. "The artists perceive these markets and fairs as a kind of filter for history, where objects have a meaning in a local context, pass from hand to hand, and carry memories and stories. In the age of globalisation and digitalisation, all this is disappearing, and so are the memories attached to the objects."

As artists highlight and put objects on a new platform, they also give them perspectives. By displaying them, they give a new potential, almost a new life to the items.

"While the objects speak to the role of a bygone European entity, the ensemble pieces of the selection also interpret the artists' approach and way of thinking."

The artists aim to create an archive that appeals to Europe's collective memory. At a time when the definition of what Europe is comes under increasing pressure, the project is a celebration of European heritage."

The exhibition opens at 18.00 on 22nd June at Dubniczay Palace and is open until 27th August.

THE WAY THEY SEE LAKE BALATON AND ITS REGION



Dafna Talmor and Noémie Goudal are the other two talented participants in our artistic residency programme. The British and French artists' exhibition opens at 18.00 on 29th June. Their works will be on display in Dubniczay Palace, the Granary and in the Veszprém Castle area.

We believe that the best place to create art about Lake Balaton is at Lake Balaton.

This is why we pay special attention to the Artists in Residency (AIR) events, which span several programmes and bring artists, invited or selected by competition, to the settlements of the region to show how they see the place through their works.

Art historian Claudia Küssel, who also acts as curator of the two artists' exhibitions, has some interesting facts about the artists and the creative process.

"Both artists focus on landscape and the relationship between landscape and image.

What is interesting for us is how they respond to the region, its natural features and the built environment.

We would like to give visitors a unique experience that they have not really had before."

One of our artists is Dafna Talmor from the UK, who works on the borderline between photography and media art.

"She specifically focuses on landscape photography. She spent several weeks in and around Veszprém. Among other things, she studied water and rocks.

Exploring the relationship between landscape and perspective, she uses a scalpel to cut, slice and reassemble her photos taken with analogue methods.

The resulting collages create interesting confrontations.

In a specific way, the analog film material abstracts both the material and the subject of the image.

She is preparing an interesting installation for the exhibition: unconventional, two-dimensional framed images will be on show in Veszprém."

Young French artist Noémie Goudal is another participant whose photographs give us a slightly different perspective of the countryside we live in. Among other places in the region, she has visited Tapolca Lake Cave, Lóczy Cave, Vadlány Hole, the Sea of Stones in Szentbékállá and the basalt organs.

"The uniqueness of her art is that in her works and landscapes she tends to make a sort of illusionistic intervention, working with film and photography.

In her very impressive large-scale photographs, she creates a peculiar visual spectacle by repositioning or exposing photographic elements in the landscape and re-photographing them together with their surroundings. She creates artworks and installations that go beyond the boundaries of photography, and in many cases she also produces performance art. She does scientific research, too, exploring the intersection of ecology and anthropology."

The works by Dafna Talmor and Noémie Goudal are on display until 27th August.



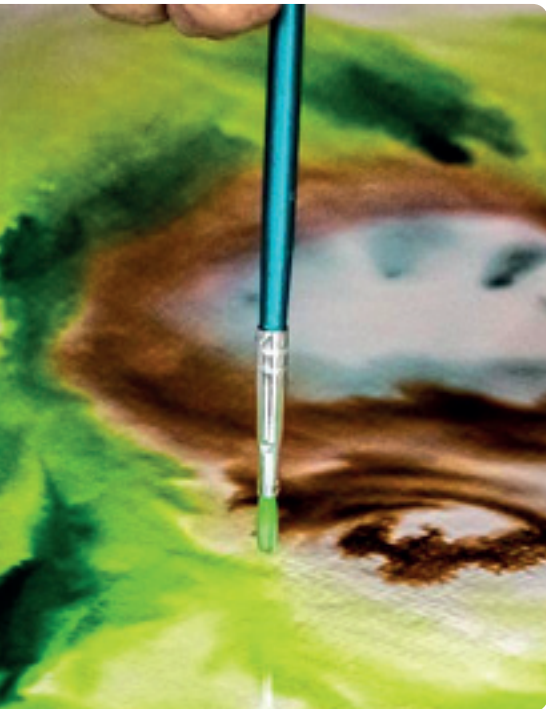

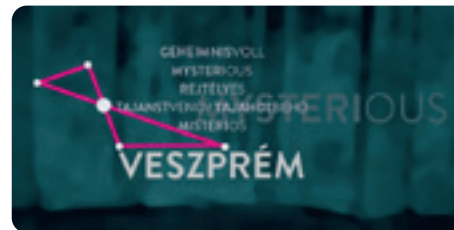

DAFNA TALMOR IS DEBUTING WITH HER NEW SITE-SPECIFIC INSTALLATION IN JUNE AT HOUSE OF ARTS, VESZPRÉM



This summer will be an extremely busy period in the life of House of Arts in Veszprém as they are planning several interesting exhibitions for visitors. As part of their BALATON EYE photography artist-in-residency programme, artists will reflect on the unique landscape of the region organized by the European Capital of Culture project. Dafna Talmor is one of the artists who has visited the Veszprém-Balaton region recently as part of her research. We have asked her about art, experiences and about the upcoming exhibition as well.

At first, could you tell us some words about yourself? How photography came into your life?

I'm an artist and lecturer based in London. I was born in Tel-Aviv, raised in Venezuela and have lived in London since the late 90s, when I moved there to study Fine Art at Goldsmiths College. Although the course was interdisciplinary, I found myself primarily using photography during my BA, so I went on to do my MA in Fine Art Photography at the Royal College of Art. Photography has always been at the core of what I do, even though my practice has also included video, events, publications, collaborations and spatial interventions.

As far as I know you have visited Hungary recently to do some research.

Yes, I was in Hungary for about three weeks from the end of March until mid-April and spent about two weeks exploring and shooting in the Veszprém-Lake Balaton region. As I haven't driven for a long time, my sister, Ruti Talmor - an academic based in the United States - joined to assist me with driving, research and documentation of the process. We were based in Veszprém and covered a lot of ground exploring an incredible range of locations and landscapes focusing on the north part of the lake, in the Balaton Uplands National Park area.

You are going to attend the opening ceremony in June, aren't you?

I plan to be back in Hungary in June to finalize some of the production in Budapest, take part in the installation of the exhibition with the curator and for the opening ceremony on the 29th June, at the House of Arts. Artist talks are planned for the same day as part of the programme of events. I'm really looking forward to it all!

ADVENTURES IN SPACE AND TIME



A novel way of discovering the city and its history will soon be available. The Veszprém County Archives of the National Archives of Hungary will launch Veszprém Map Wanderer on 15 June, Hungarian Archives Day.

Based on the street and buildings structure of the historical core of the city of Veszprém between 1850 and 1950, the National Archives of Hungary is creating a local history database called Veszprém Map Wanderr, which will display the historical data of streets, houses and their inhabitants on digitalised, interactive, multi-layered historical maps.

The database will also include digital images of selected archival sources linked to houses and plots. The application will allow you to roam in space and time through Veszprém's past, tracing the transformation of the town temporally and spatially from the mid-19th to the mid-20th century.

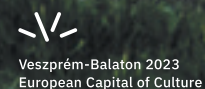

LAMPLIGHT - SUNG VERSES



On 18th June, the Ruin Concerts series will once again welcome audiences to a special venue, the synagogue of Kővágóörs.

On that occasion, verses set to music by 20th century Hungarian poets will be performed by Veronika Harcsa and Bálint Gyémánt in an event entitled Lámpafény (Lamplight).

Veszprém and the Lake Balaton Uplands have a uniquely rich medieval heritage. Walking around the region, you will often come across ruins of monasteries, churches, chapels and castles. These ruins will be filled with life and art in the Veszprém-Balaton 2023 European Capital of Culture Ruin Concerts series.

On 18th June, the evening will start at 18.00 at the synagogue of Kővágóörs, with performances by internationally renowned musicians Veronika Harcsa and Bálint Gyémánt. Their collaboration dates back to years spent at the Liszt Academy of Music.

Although their last two albums were recorded as a quartet with two Belgian musicians, the core of their work together remains the duo line-up.

They have worked out how to achieve the most complete sound with a single guitar and singing voice, and their songs are personally inspired, with depth, a sense of freedom and humour. The duo has toured some forty countries and numerous festivals, and their concerts give audiences the opportunity to witness creative, experimental, genre-blending musical stories. In the Lámpafény performance, which is free of charge and open to the public, Veronika Harcsa and Bálint Gyémánt will perform lesser-known poems by well-known 20th century Hungarian poets. The guest of the show will be Mihály Dresch, a prominent figure of the Hungarian jazz scene.

The poems were selected and set to music by Veronika Harcsa with the assistance of her band members.

The performance will include poems by Attila József, Árpád Tóth, Dezső Kosztolányi, Mihály Babits, Sándor Weöres, Ágnes Nemes Nagy, Lajos Kassák and Frigyes Karinthy.

TUNED TO NATURE



Where the invisible becomes visible, silence becomes audible, all with perfect simplicity. From May to September 2023, Hungarian popular music bands will perform five times at iconic nature sites and geological gems of the Veszprém-Balaton region.

The overall aim of the concert series is to expand the cultural offer and spaces of the region, showcasing the natural treasures of the land with versatile musical performers, in a sustainable way, with minimal environmental impact, to smaller audiences. An intimate atmosphere is guaranteed, with audiences ranging from 50 to 120 people, depending on the size of the venue. Protecting nature's resources is a key element of the programme, which is why the concerts are organised as "zero waste" events. All the venues are located along nature trails or hiking paths, giving participants the opportunity to discover unique natural and geological wonders. During the events, participants can try out different instruments and get closer to each other through jamming, thus enhancing the power of community experience. All events are free of charge, subject to individual registration, and participants can support the initiative with an on-the-spot contribution.

Hungarian Ballet Grand Prix

Veszprém hosts the first international competition for ballet students in Hungary. Children and young dancers will dazzle the audience and the jury between 26th and 29th June.

Veszprém has a long tradition of this fine art form, as a ballet school has been operating for almost a decade under the direction of Viktoria Podolskaya, and has nurtured many renowned artists. ActiCity, one of the city’s most recently opened venues, is now hosting the Hungarian Ballet Grand Prix. The international dance competition will see dancers aged between 7 and 18 test their skills and dancing abilities. “We are also counting on the interest of those who may have previously thought ballet to be an inaccessible, perhaps overly exalted genre. Classical ballet is indeed a little distant to many, as performances that showcase classical ballet are presented at the State Opera. We would like to bring this genre closer to the people, to demonstrate and raise awareness

that ballet belongs to everyone,” said Annamária Isky, the competition’s initiator and chair of the Board of Trustees of the State Opera Ballet Students’ Foundation. The competition also aims to discover talented young people who might become the ballet artists of the future. And although many girls dream of twirling, spinning and dancing in the glamour, dance is also an art form for couples, so getting boys involved is also a priority.



The competition will feature amateur and professional dancers performing classical and modern dances in solo, pair and group formations.

“We would like as many people as possible to think of our competition as a festival. We have designed this four-day competition so that everyone can find a programme that suits them”.

The event also has a tourism dimension, which is reflected in the slogan: “Ballet competition packed with Lake Balaton experiences. Balatonalmádi - where the competitors will be staying - will be getting people in the mood for dancing from the beginning of June with a new cultural community space set up by HybridArt, with an exhibition entitled “Blok” and a number of thematic programmes in the town centre.

Goldilocks weeps over the young fairy boy, and the tears of sorrow that gather form our beautiful lake, Lake Balaton.

The production is about love of brothers and sisters, loyalty and sacrifice, enriched with wonderful visual elements, and incorporating



the movement of water, presented by the artists: actors, musicians, dancers. Alela Theatre's production is set on the waters of Lake Balaton, using music and visuals, and telling the story in song, which the audience can watch from the shores of the lake.

SLOWWALK is designed to help you perceive and understand the interrelationships and functioning of the Lake Balaton landscape around us. During the slow walks you can experience the unique characteristics and ecological relationships of the landscape.

Beach Pastures, szabadonbalaton x Anna Varga joint landscape walk

Can you still take a dip in Lake Balaton if you're an animal? Not so long ago, waterfronts were also meeting places between animals and people. In the Lake Balaton region, the landscape was traditionally used for extensive grazing until a few decades ago. Grazing

maintained species-rich, mosaic-like, open habitats that are both beautiful and valuable for human use. Why is the extent to which animals are able to move freely around the areas surrounding Lake Balaton and along the waterfronts important for ecological connectivity? This performance walk, which lasts a few hours, explores the relationship between Lake Balaton and animal husbandry through the cultural, historical and ecological connections between beaches and pastures.

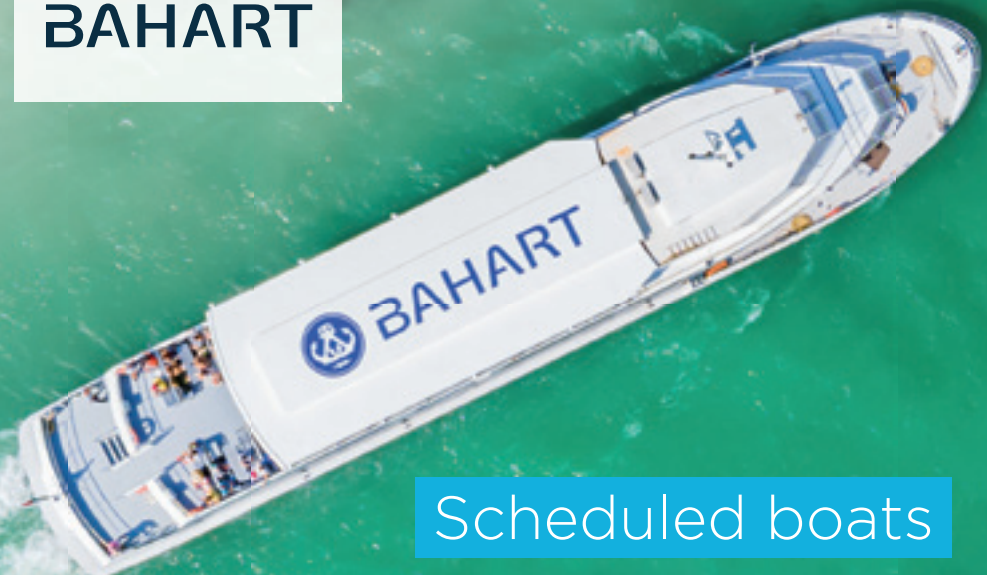
